Note that submissions of paper, which are uploaded only on arXiv.org, are not considered as dual submission, and such papers are allowed to be submitted to NCVPRIPG 2019.

All submitted papers will be peer reviewed (double-blind). Please submit the paper without providing the author details in the paper or in supplementary material. In addition, the authors should also make sure that such details are also not being provided indirectly (e.g. self-citations in third person, avoiding acknowledgements etc.).
